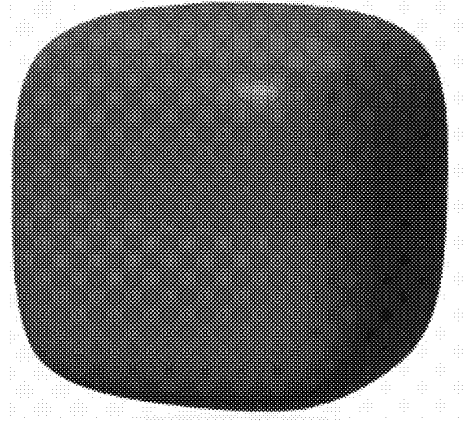

When this animation executes, it starts with a much closer view of the “farther” away cubes, and the viewer can clearly see that such cubes do not have the word “redbox” on such cubes. Based on the small sizing of the word “redbox” on the two closer geometric cubes and based on the word “redbox” not appearing on the other geometric cubes, Applicant asserts that the geometric cube alone creates a separate and distinct commercial impression apart from word “redbox.” Thus, for at least these reasons, the specimen should be acceptable and Applicant respectfully requests that the present objection be withdrawn.
